



## Crochet decorative pine cones

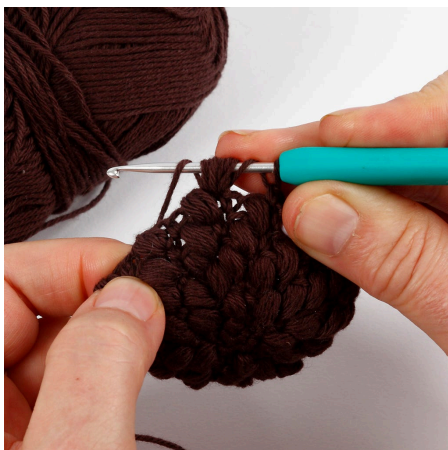
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Crochet decorative pine cones with puff stitches as scales. This is a simple guide with only a few stitch variants. Crochet a magic ring, crochet double crochet stitches and puff stitches. Fill the pine cone with carded wool. The finished pine cone measures approx. 6 cm.

### *Comment faire*



**1** Crochet the pine cone using the crochet pattern which is available as a PDF file on this page. Begin the pine cone with a magic ring. Find more information in creative techniques idea No. 15138.



**2** Make the pine cone scales with puff stitches (with 9 loops on the crochet hook). Find more information in creative techniques idea No. 15959.



**3** Use a stitch marker to keep count of the rounds.



# A crocheted pine cone

Height approx. 6 cm  
No. 2.5 crochet hook

- 1: 6 dc around a magic circle
- 2: 2 dc in each dc **(12 dc)**
- 3: \*1 dc, 1 ps\*. Repeat from \* to \* until you have reached the end of the rd **(6 dc & 6 ps)**
- 4: \*1 dc, 1 ps and 1 dc in the same dc, 1 ps\*. Repeat from \* to \* until you have reached the end of the rd **(12 ps & 12 dc)**
- 5-10: \*1 dc, 1 ps\*. Repeat from \* to \*. Stagger ps by one st per rd **(12 ps & 12 dc)**
- 11: \*2 dc tog, 1 ps\*. Repeat from \* to \* until you have reached the end of the rd **(6 dc & 6 ps)**
- 12: \*1 dc, 1 ps\*. Repeat from \* to \* until you have reached the end of the rd **(6 dc & 6 ps)**

*Fill with carded wool and shape into an oblong pine cone  
(the filling largely dictates the shape)*

- 13: 2 dc tog until you have reached the end of the rd **(6 dc)**
- 14: 1 dc in each dc. Cut the wool, sew it around the rd and secure the end.



## Forkortelser og symbolforklaring

rd/rds = round/rounds  
st = stitch  
dc = double crochet

ps = puff stitch (with 9 loops on the crochet hook)  
tog = together
