

## A vase with a plaster surface and mosaics

Add a new lease of life to vases by applying a thin coat of plaster. Push glass mosaic fragments and sea shells into the wet plaster for a beautiful look.





**1** Use plaster on glass as it sticks well and offers the possibility of adding a new lease of life to various vases whether they are from a second hand shop or from your cupboard.



2 Mix Cera-Mix standard plaster casting compound and water so that the consistency resembles mayonnaise. You will need 1 cup of Cera-Mix standard plaster casting compound to 1/2 cup of water. Don't mix too large amounts at a time as the mixture sets quickly.



**3** Apply the plaster with modelling tools.









**4** Make different patterns and dots on the surface using modelling tools.

**5** Apply a 1-3 mm thick layer of plaster onto the glass item.



**6** Press the glass mosaic fragments and the sea shells in the plaster as you go along before the plaster sets. You may smooth out the plaster with a bit of water on your finger.



**7** A tip: Make the plaster surface appear more clearly by applying the plaster more roughly.
