



## Moss stitched bag

Use No. 3 knitting needles. One ball of cotton twine is used for one bag.

### *Comment faire*



**1** Using cotton twine cast on 50 stitches and knit moss stitches until the piece measures approx. 35-40cm. Then decrease to make a pointed tip; two stitches on each side, nine times – i.e. 14 stitches left. Cast off. Cut a piece of canvas in the same size as the bag + seam and sew this onto one side of the bag.



**2** Sew the crochet lace borders onto the front of the bag.



**Shoulder strap** Cast on 8 stitches and knit moss stitches to your desired length. Cut a piece of canvas double the size of the strap's width, fold over and sew this piece onto one side of the strap.





**Assembling** Fold over the bag and sew the shoulder strap onto the sides from the base of the bag.



**5** Crochet a small loop for the button on the front of the bag. Use doubled over cotton twine.



**6** Sew on a wooden bead as a button.
