



## A Wind Chime in Shrink Plastic Sheets

The decorative wind chimes are made from shrink plastic sheets decorated with Groove coloured pencils and then shrunk in the oven. A Mandalas colouring book is used as a template for the patterns of the circle. There is also a template for the leaves. You can easily become totally absorbed with colouring the patterns. Choose a glossy high-quality polyester cord for hanging to ensure good motion in the wind chime,. Make sure to hang the leaves, so they hit each other when moving.

### *Comment faire*



**1.** Put the Mandala design under the transparent shrink plastic sheet. Turn the shiny side down and draw on the rough side. Draw the design with a colouring pencil and fill in. Draw the leaves in the same way using the template and fill in.



**2.** Cut out the designs. Make holes with revolving punch pliers.



**3.** Put the design in a preheated oven at 130C for a few minutes. Stay by the oven whilst the design shrinks for approx. 1 minute and take it out of the oven when the design has straightened again.





4. Attach a glossy high-quality polyester cord and add beads for the wind chime's leaves.
