

## Plaster Cast and painted Figures

The plaster figures are made from casting compound, mixed with water and poured into moulds. After hardening, the figures are painted in a base colour using A-Color Glass paint and details are added with glass and porcelain markers.

## Comment faire



1. Follow the indicated mixing ratio of water and casting compound on the packaging of the casting compound and sprinkle the casting compound into the waster until a small peak has formed on the surface of the water. Stir the mixture to a soft mush and pour into the mould. Tap the mould lightly with your hand to avoid air bubbles in the plaster. Let it dry and harden.



**2.** Remove the mould from the plaster cast. Scrape off any unevenness on the figure with a craft knife.



**3.** Paint the plaster cast with A-Color Glass paint and let it dry.







**4.** Draw designs with a black glass and porcelain marker.



**5.** Fill in the drawn design using glass and porcelain markers in different colours.
