



Blocs d'aquarelle

Une technique où la couleur est diluée avec de l'eau, ce qui rend transparent l'aquarelle peinte sur du papier blanc.

Comment faire



1. Sketch a design on watercolour paper with a pencil, preferably with HB grade as it gives a fine line without smudging.



2. Important (if the watercolour paper is not from a pad with glued edges): Attach the paper onto the work table with masking tape, preventing the paper from bowing upwards when painting. A tip: protect the table by placing a plastic pocket underneath.



3. Wet-on-dry: dip the brush in water, then get the watercolour from the palette and paint on the watercolour paper.





4. Wet-on-wet: prior to painting, moisten the watercolour paper with water using a sponge. Dip the brush in water, take the watercolour from the palette and paint on the moist watercolour paper.
