



## A crocheted Dishcloth using Double Crochet Stitches

This dishcloth is crocheted using double crochet stitches which is one of the basic crocheting techniques. We have used cotton yarn 8/4 on No. 3 crochet hook.

### *Comment faire*



**A tip!** In order for the dishcloths to keep the colours from fading, you may soak them in cold water adding a small amount of white vinegar. This should also improve their absorbency.

**3** Wash the dishcloths before use at 40°C.

# A crocheted Dishcloth using Double Crochet Stitches

This dishcloth is crocheted using double crochet stitches which is one of the basic crocheting techniques. We have used cotton yarn 8/4 on No. 3 crochet hook.

## **A TIP!**

In order for the dishcloths to keep the colours from fading, you may soak them in cold water adding a small amount of white vinegar. This should also improve their absorbency.

Wash the dishcloths before use.

You will need approx. 27 g of yarn for a dishcloth measuring 19 x 19 cm.

## How to crochet the dishcloth:

- Step 1: Start by making a loop.
- Step 2: Chain 50 cs. Turn over.
- Step 3: Crochet 1 dc in the 2nd cs from the hook.
- Step 4: Crochet dc till the end of the row.
- Step 5: Crochet 1 cs for turning (i.e. a turning chain). Turn over.
- Step 6: Crochet ds till the end of the row.
- Step 7: Crochet a cs for turning (i.e. a turning chain).
- Step 8: Continue with dc for 27 rows.
- Step 9: Cut the yarn, pull the end of the yarn through the loop. Tighten.
