

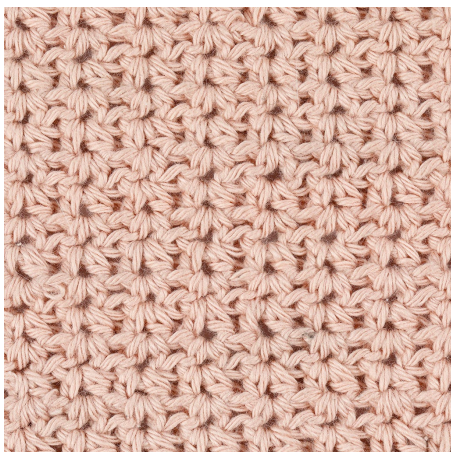


A crocheted Dishcloth with a Shell Stitch Style Pattern

This dishcloth is crocheted with half treble crochet stitches in a v-pattern using cotton yarn 8/4 on No. 3 crochet hook.

Comment faire



A tip! In order for the dishcloths to keep the colours from fading, you may soak them in cold water adding a small amount of white vinegar. This should also improve their absorbency.



3 Wash the dishcloths before use at 40°C.

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A TIP!

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Wash the dishcloths before use.

How to crochet the dishcloth:

If you want a dishcloth in a different size than 23 x 23 cm, then start with a different equal number of stitches.

Begin with 40 cs. Two of the cs are turning chains.

1st row: (1 htr, 1 cs, 1 htr) in the 4th cs from the hook, * skip the next cs, (1 htr, 1 cs, 1 htr) in the next cs *. Repeat from * to * until the last 2 cs, skip 1 cs, 1 htr in the last cs. Turn with 2 cs.

2nd row: * Skip 2 htr, (1 htr, 1 cs, 1 htr) around the next cs *. Repeat from * to * until the last cs, skip 1 htr, 1 htr in the turning chain. Turn with 2 cs.

Repeat row number 2 until the dishcloth is square and then bind off.



Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

Cs = Chain stitch

Htr = Half treble crochet stitch
