



A crocheted Make-up Bag with Ombre Effect

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Crochet your own make-up bag with ombre effect. You will be crocheting with two balls of wool throughout which makes the ombre effect easy to achieve. Sew a ready-made pencil case onto the inside of the crocheted make-up bag, providing the finished make-up bag with a lining and a zip.

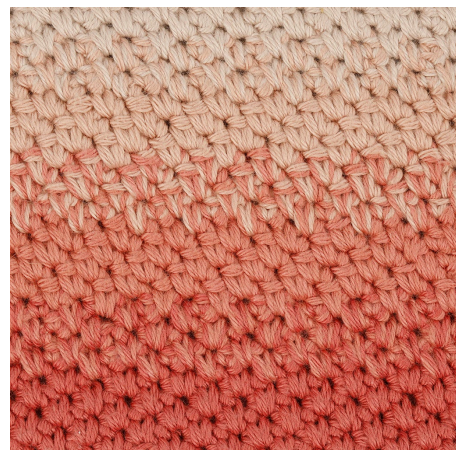

1 Crochet the make-up bag using the crochet pattern which is available as a PDF file on this page. Sew the ready-made pencil case onto the inside of the crocheted make-up bag either with small tacking stitches by hand or on the sewing machine.



2 After mounting you won't be able to see the ready-made fabric pencil case which acts as the lining and a zip for the make-up bag.



3 Here is a close up of the pattern and the ombre effect.



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No. 4 crochet hook

A needle and white thread for sewing the pencil case inside the crocheted purse .

Crochet with double yarn strands throughout.

How to crochet the make-up bag:

Step 1: Crochet 37 cs with colour No. 1

Step 2: Crochet the first row as dc

Step 3: Crochet 2 dc in the back loop of the 2nd chain from the crochet hook. Continue with dc stitches until you have finished the row, with the exception of the last cs; crochet 2 dc in the last cs.

Step 4: Crochet on the opposite of the chain band. Crochet dc stitches in all the stitches, with the exception of the last cs in which you will need to crochet 2 dc. You now have 77 stitches.

Step 5: Crochet dc round the entire row (77 stitches). Crochet on both sides of the chain band, so that the number of stitches doubles and you work in the round.

Step 6: Crochet *1 dc, 1 ddc*. Repeat the pattern from * to *.

Step 8: Crochet the next round in the opposite way, beginning with 1 ddc followed by 1 dc.

Step 8: Crochet 5 rounds in total with this pattern with colour No. 1.

Step 9: Swap one yarn strand with colour No. 2. Crochet 3 rounds with colour No. 1 and No. 2 together.

Step 10: Swap colour No. 1 with colour No. 2, crocheting with the same colour for 4 rounds.

Step 11: Swap one yarn strand with colour No. 3. Crochet 3 rounds with colour No. 2 and colour No. 3 together.

Step 12: Swap colour No. 2 with colour No. 3, crocheting with the same colour for 4 rounds.

Step 13: Swap one yarn strand with colour No. 4. Crochet 3 rounds with colour No. 3 and colour No. 4 together.

Step 14: Swap colour No. 3 with colour No. 4, crocheting with the same colour for 4 rounds.

Step 15: Finish with one round of dc.

Secure the ends and sew the ready-made fabric pencil case onto the inside of the make-up bag.



Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

Cs = Chain stitch

Dc = Double crochet

Ddc = Deep double crochet (crochet like a normal double crochet stitch, but in the chain in the row below).
