

A crocheted Drum from Cotton Tube Yarn

This drum is crocheted on a No. 8 crochet hook using one ball of red, two balls of white and one ball of grey cotton tube yarn. You will need polyester stuffing to fill a 28 cm high drum with a diameter of 21 cm.

Comment faire



1 Crochet the drum following the pattern on the attached PDF file. Fill the drum with polyester stuffing prior to closing.



2 Crochet the top and bottom onto the drum tube using double crochet stitches.



3 Use Lurex gold yarn (double yarn) for crocheting a row of double crochet stitches between the red crocheted section and the section with the grey and white pattern.







4 Crochet a 30 cm piece of cord from Lurex gold yarn using basic chain stitches. Double over the crocheted piece of cord and tie a knot in the middle. Sew the cord onto the drum using Lurex gold yarn. Tie bells to both ends and finish with a bow.





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This drum is crocheted on a No. 8 crochet hook using one ball of red, two balls of white and one ball of grey cotton tube yarn. You will need polyester stuffing to fill a 28 cm high drum with a diameter of 21 cm.

Diameter 21 cm, height 28 cm. 2 balls of white cotton tube yarn 1 ball of grey cotton tube yarn 1 ball of red cotton tube yarn No. 8 crochet hook Crocheted with double crochet stitches in the back loop of the stitch.

Bottom and top – make a total of 2 circles, white cotton tube yarn

- Crochet 6 dc in a ring 1.
- 2. Crochet 2 dc in each stitch, in total 12 stitches
- Crochet *1 dc and 1 inc*, in total 18 stitches 3.
- Crochet *2 dc and 1 inc*, in total 24 stitches 4.
- 5. Crochet *3 dc and 1 inc*, in total 30 stitches
- Crochet *4 dc and 1 inc*, in total 36 stitches 6.
- 7. Crochet *5 dc and 1 inc*, in total 42 stitches
- Crochet *6 dc and 1 inc*, in total 48 stitches 8.



Abbreviations and symbols explanation:

dc = double crochet inc = increase

= repeat from * to *

The tube of the drum

- 1. 47 cs with red cotton tube yarn. Crochet the cord with the chain stitches together with a dc to make a magic ring. A total of 48 stitches. Crochet 3 rows using dc. 2. Change to white and crochet 1 row using dc. 3. Crochet the triangle; 10 white dc, 2 grey dc. 4. Continue like this to the end of the row. 5.
- Repeat
- Crochet 8 dc, 4 grey dc. Continue like this to the 6. end of the row.
- 7. Repeat
- 8. Crochet 6 white dc, 6 grey dc. Continue like this to the end of the row.
- 9. Repeat
- Crochet 4 white dc, 8 grey dc. Continue like this to 10. the end of the row.
- 11. Repeat
- Crochet 2 white dc, 10 grey dc. Continue like this to 12. the end of the row.
- 13. Repeat
- 14. Crochet 1 row of dc using grey cotton tube yarn.

15. Crochet 3 rows of dc using red cotton tube yarn.

Finish.

Crochet the top and the bottom circles onto the drum tube with red cotton tube yarn using dc. Fill the tube with polyester stuffing prior to closing.

For decoration use Lurex gold yarn (double yarn) for crocheting a row of double crochet stitches on the drum tube between the red crocheted section and the section with the grey and white triangulars at the top and the bottom.

Crochet a 30 cm piece of cord from Lurex gold yarn using basic chain stitches. Tie bells to both ends.

Double over the crocheted piece of cord and tie a knot. Tie or sew the cord onto the drum using Lurex gold yarn. Tie a bow with the two ends.
