



Une méduse et un poisson faits à partir d'une lampe en papier de riz décorée avec de la peinture acrylique et du papier de soie

Transformez les lampes en papier de riz en une méduse et un poisson. Peignez les lampes en papier de riz avec de la peinture acrylique et fixez-y du papier de soie pour les tentacules, la queue et les nageoires.

Comment faire



1 Fabriquez la méduse en tamponnant la peinture acrylique Plus Color sur la partie supérieure de la lampe en papier de riz en forme de goutte à l'aide d'un tampon en mousse.



2 Place several sheets of tissue paper on top of each other and draw a circle around a small plate. Cut out the tissue paper circle.



3 Cut the circles into a spiral shape as shown in the photo.





4 Tie the spiral strips of tissue paper together with a piece of thread.



5 Feed each end of the thread through the holes at the top of the rice paper lamp.



6 Tie a double knot so that the tissue paper strips are hanging down from the inside of the rice paper lamp.



7 Draw eyes and a mouth with a Plus Color marker.



8 The finished jellyfish.



9 Make the fish by assembling the round rice paper lamp and then painting it with Plus Color craft paint.



10 Print the template for this idea and cut the fins for the fish from tissue paper.



11 Fold one end of the fin as shown in the photo.



12 Attach the fin onto the fish.






13 Make the tail by placing two pieces of tissue paper on top of each other (approx. 25 x 25 cm). Round the sides as shown in the photo.



14 Fold the tail with the rounded sides turned outwards.



15 Fold in half.



16 Attach the tail onto the fish using a glue stick.



17 The finished fish.
