Recouvrez des œufs en deux parties en papier mâché avec de la pâte à papier mâché et des fleurs séchées.

### *Comment faire*



**1** Add different looks to the eggs with dried flowers mixed with papier-mâché pulp.



**2** Crush a handful of dried marigolds in a bucket.



**3** Add a cup of water and mix.



**4** Add 3 cups of papier-mâché pulp.



**5** Mix well.



**6** Cover both halves of the egg with the papier-mâché pulp. Make sure that the edge on the bottom half of the egg is not covered with papier-mâché pulp.





**7** Add dried flowers to the lid whilst the papier-mâché pulp is still wet.



**8** Check the lid edge to ensure it is smooth.



**9** Make sure that the lid fits. Leave to dry.



**10** Decorate another egg, mixing rose petals from rose buds into the papier-mâché pulp – try not to crush the petals.



**11** Cover the egg, put on the lid and leave it to dry.



**12** Decorate another egg, slightly crushing the petals from the rose buds and mixing them with the papier-mâché pulp.



**13** Cover the egg with the papier-mâché pulp, put the lid on and leave it to dry.
