



A crocheted doughnut keyring



Crochet your very own doughnut and use it in the play kitchen or as a decorative pendant on a keyring for a rucksack or a handbag. Crochet the doughnut in a light beige/sand colour and crochet the icing in your chosen colour. Finish by embroidering sprinkles on the icing. Please note that the finished doughnut measures approx. 7 cm in diameter.

hoe werkt het



1 Sew the crocheted doughnut together, filling it with polyester wadding as you go along.



2 Sew wooden beads onto the crocheted icing for the eyes. Embroider the mouth with black embroidery floss.



3 Embroider sprinkles in different colours on the icing.



4 Sew the crocheted decorated icing onto the inner ring of the doughnut.



5 Sew the outer icing edge onto the doughnut all the way around and secure the ends to prevent any holes appearing at the treble stitches.



A crocheted doughnut

A crocheted doughnut measuring 6.5 cm in diameter. Crocheted using 8/4 cotton yarn and a 3.0 mm crochet hook. The sprinkle is embroidered with 8/4 cotton yarn. The mouth is embroidered with Harmony embroidery floss. Wooden beads (5 mm diameter) are used for the eyes. The keyring with a snake chain is sewn on with 8/4 cotton yarn.

Doughnut:

Use a 3.0 mm crochet hook.

1. Crochet 22 ch and make a magic circle with 1 sl st **(22)**
2. 1 ch * 1 dc, 2 dc in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times, finish with dc **(33)**
3. 33 dc **(33)**
4. * 2 dc, 2 dc in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc **(44)**
- 5-11. 44 dc **(44)**
12. * 2 dc, 2 dc together in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc **(33)**
13. 33 dc **(33)**
14. * 1 dc, 2 dc together in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc **(22)**
15. 22 dc. Finish with sl st **(22)**

Bind off and leave the yarn long. The yarn end will be used for sewing the doughnut together.

Fill with polyester wadding as you go along whilst sewing the doughnut together.



Icing:

1. Crochet 22 ch and make a magic circle with 1 sl st **(22)**
2. 1 ch * 1 dc, 2 dc in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times, finish with dc **(33)**
3. 33 dc **(33)**
4. * 2 dc, 2 dc in the next st *. Repeat from * to * a total of 10 times. Finish with dc **(44)**
5. 44 dc **(44)**
6. 1 dc, 4 ch, 1st ch is a turning chain (tch), 3 htr in the next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the next dc.
4 dc, 6 ch, the 2 ch are turning chains (tch), 4 tr in the next 4 ch, 1 sl st in the fourth dc.
5 dc, 4 ch, 1st ch is a turning chain (tch), 3 htr in the next 3 ch, 1 sl st in the next dc.
4 dc, 7 ch, the 2 ch are turning chains (tch), 5 tr in the next 5 ch, 1 sl st in the fourth dc.
2 dc, 3 ch, 1st ch is a turning chain (tch), 2 htr in the next 2 ch, 1 sl st in the next dc.
5 dc, 5 ch, 1st ch is a turning chain (tch), 4 tr in the next 4 ch, 1 sl st in the third dc.
3 dc, 3 ch, 1st ch is a turning chain (tch), 2 htr in the next 2 ch, 1 sl st in the next dc.
4 dc, finish with sl st, bind off.

Embroider sprinkles on the icing. Sew the icing onto the doughnut.

Abbreviation and symbol explanation:

st = stitch
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch

dc = double crochet
htr = half treble
tr = treble
